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Generate five engaging, open-ended discussion questions based on your chosen book.

- The Boy Who Harnessed the Wind by William Kamkwamba and Bryan Mealer
- Maus I by Art Spiegelman
- Piecing Me Together by Renée Watson

Your task is to illuminate the **big ideas** in the reading with the goal in mind of sharing your reactions with peers during the first weeks of school.

- These should not be recall or reading comprehension questions; your questions should not lead to yes/no or single word/phrase answers. Your answers should be well-developed.
- Usually the best discussion questions come from your own thoughts, feelings and concerns as you read. (Why, how, what was the significance of, what was the author's intent are some discussion question starters.)
- If any of your questions relate to a particular passage, make sure to <u>include the page</u> <u>number</u> at the end of your question.
- Consider how your chosen book helped you to better understand humanity (i.e., How do people/characters think, behave and interact? How do people/characters view the world? In what ways are these perspectives similar to or different from yours?)
