Over the past few weeks there has been misleading information regarding The Key School and our intentions for the Property within your community. We want to assure open communication that will avoid any misunderstanding. The attached document provides many important facts regarding the proposed use of the Property. We hope this information addresses many of the community's concerns.

The most important "fact" is that Key will abide by the covenants in the June 3, 1987 Declaration. Those covenants, which include recreational, horticultural and conservation activities and associated structures, are consistent with our intentions.

Please take the time to review the information regarding the purpose of Key's purchase and the proposed use. When there is a definite plan (e.g., location of recreational facilities, accessory structures, parking, etc.), we would like to present our intentions to the entire community.
