Update: January 18, 2018

Many factors have affected the construction schedule shared on January 4, including weather. As of this update, road widening and swale grading are slated to begin on Monday, January 22. The necessary relocation of designated mailboxes and other obstructions located in the current right-of-way will occur as the road widening progresses along Carrollton Road over the next several weeks. The work will begin toward the front of the neighborhood, on the Fusco Athletic Park side of the road, moving to the Park, and then proceed back down Carrollton. As stated earlier, one lane of traffic will remain open at all times and flaggers will be directing traffic throughout the project. The information shared is based on our current knowledge; however, there is always the chance that our plans may need to be adjusted based on factors outside our control. Updates about the road widening will be posted weekly throughout the project.
